**PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING TO PAUL VI
FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS**

Complete enclosed Paul VI application form and mail to the Paul VI Registrar Office.

By January, send this form to your student's 8th grade teacher requesting a copy of your student's academic records from 6th, 7th, and 8th grades, including results of standardized test scores. These records must reach Paul VI before February 2008 in order for the process to be completed in time for registration on March 8, 2008.
