

NCAA REGULATIONS

Any student interested in participating in athletics in a Division I or Division II program in college and receiving athletically based financial aid, must register with the NCAA Eligibility Center and meet academic eligibility standards. Students should register at the end of junior year. In order to register with the eligibility center, you must have a valid U.S. Social Security Number and credit card. The cost is \$50.

You can register on line at www.ncaaclearinghouse.net and follow the online instructions. You must download two copies of the **student release form** (Copy 1 and Copy 2) and bring them to the registrar. She will mail your transcript at the end of junior year and again at the completion of senior year to the NCAA Clearinghouse for processing.

Important Note:

Transcripts and test scores must be sent directly to the eligibility center. These documents cannot be faxed or submitted online. Test scores must come to the eligibility center directly from the testing agencies. In order to have these scores sent to the eligibility center use code "9999" when registering for the SAT or ACT. Test scores received as part of the high school transcript are not accepted by the NCAA eligibility center.
